SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT



This document has been assembled in order to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission when returning to games with crowds at the AJ Bell Stadium.

The safety of our fans and staff is paramount and it is everyone's responsibility to ENSURE that the guidelines laid out below are respected and followed.

By entering the ballot or purchasing a match ticket you are stating that you agree to the control measures put in place. Failure to abide by these may result in ejection from the stadium in the interest of public health and safety. Thank you for your compliance.

HEALTH DECLARATION

I confirm I will not attend if I or any member of my household has experienced any of the following symptoms set in the last 24 hours:

- have a high temperature (37.8 or higher)
- have a new onset of a continuous cough.
- have loss of or change in normal sense of taste or smell.

I confirm I will not attend if I have been contacted in line with the NHS Test and Trace or any other relevant body and are required to self-isolate or quarantine.

STADIUM INFORMATION

I confirm I will adhere to the stadium ground regulations (attached) and acknowledge the messaging below:

- The AJ Bell Stadium is working with the NHS Test and Trace system and QR codes will be visible at turnstiles and inside the stadium should you wish to scan.
- You must enter the stadium at the time detailed on your ticket, you may be refused entry should you not arrive at the specified time.
- Stadium signage and direction from stewards must be followed at all times. There will be a one-way system in place. Fans will enter through the turnstiles and walk pitch-side to get to their seats.
- You may be temperature checked on arrival to the stadium.
- Personal bags should be no bigger than A4 size and searches may take place upon entry to the stadium.
- Social distancing must be observed at all times. Please be aware of the people around you and give them space. If moving past people on the same row, please turn your back to them in order to avoid face-to-face contact.
- Fans aged 11+ must wear a face covering when in the stadium, except when eating and drinking or if exempt (you may be challenged if not wearing a mask). We advise masks to also be worn outside the stadium.

- Only a person named on the ticket will be allowed access. Photo ID if entering the stadium on a concession ticket you may be asked to produce ID, if this cannot be produced you will not be permitted entry to the stadium.
- Toilets and kiosks are accessible via the vomitories, following the one-way system.
- You should go straight to your seat as detailed on your ticket and not congregate en route.
- Although there will be spare seats around you, in order to comply with social distancing measures, you must remain in your allocated seat.
- COVID security require that everyone in a seated area must remain seated whilst watching the game, anyone standing persistently may be ejected.
- All under 16's must be accompanied by an adult and that adult must be responsible for ensuring the under 16 adheres to all measures.
- KIOSKS will not be open in the standing areas in line with DCMS regulations. You can only eat and drink when seated therefore kiosks in the EAST & WEST Stand will operate with a reduced menu. Please follow all guidance on queuing safely and please pay contactless if possible.
- At the final whistle, you will be asked to stay in your seat while the exit is controlled with spectators leaving block by block.

SPECTATOR BEHAVIOUR

- Sanitiser will be available on entry and around the stadium. Please maintain good hygiene and avoid touching your face where possible.
- It is important to avoid physical contact with people outside your bubble.
- Observe good respiratory etiquette at all times, especially when coughing or sneezing.
- Should you feel unwell, particularly with a cough or high temperature, please contact your nearest steward immediately.
- You should make every effort is pursued to reduce airborne transmission of the virus by controlling levels of emotion during the game. Cheering, singing, clapping and shouting should not be encouraged. Please be considerate of everybody else in the stadium.
- DO NOT approach anyone inside or outside the stadium for selfies or autographs.
- Please respect personal space of fellow spectators, staff and players.
- If in the event of the match ball leaving the field of play, please do not throw the ball back down onto the pitch. An amber zone ball operative will come and collect the ball from you or ask you to pass it to them to be sanitised.
- Inconsiderate, reckless and anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated.

We appreciate a lot of the guidance above may impact on your ability to enjoy the game as you previously have but we stress that these regulations are important in being able to operate the stadium with fans in safely. It is crucial that you all respect them to ensure we are allowed to have you all back at games. Your cooperation and understanding is greatly appreciated.
